



Comprehension Assessment Graphic Organizer

Assessment directions:

Choose a fiction book on your child's reading level. After reading the book, have him or her draw all of the events in the story in order onto the movie reel below. You can tell them they will be working on sequencing, or retelling the events of a story in order. Use as many frames as necessary, but he or she may not need to use all the boxes, depending on the book. Remind them they do not need to draw elaborate pictures, but simple sketches. You can have your child then explain each picture/event, so that you can determine how well your child was able to tell the story in correct sequence, without missing events.
