2-player game



Directions:

- 1. Cut apart the fluency cards.
- 2. Stack the fluency cards upside down in the middle of the two players.
- 3. Player #1 draws a card and reads the sentence on the card. If the sentence is read correctly, player #1 gets to keep the card. If the card is not read correctly, it goes on the bottom of the deck.
- 4. If the player draws a "BONUS" card, the player gets to go again. Do not return "BONUS" cards back to the deck. They should be placed in the discard pile.
- 5. If the player draws an "OH NO" card, the player must return all of their cards to the pile. Do not return "OH NO" cards back to the deck. They should be placed in the discard pile.
- 6. Player #2 repeats the third step.
- 7. When the deck is all gone, the player with the most cards wins the game.
