

Comprehension Assessment Graphic Organizer

Assessment directions:

Choose a fiction book on your child's reading level. After your child reads the book (or, if need be, you may read to your child), ask your child to draw the responses to the following questions. Tell them the drawings do not need to be perfect but just sketches. Write what they tell you each picture represents, but do not help them. At the end, determine if your child was able to identify all the characters independently, identify all the settings independently, and correctly draw/tell the main event in the beginning, middle, and end of the story.

Who are all the CHARACTERS? Draw and label them in the stars below. If there are less than 4, leave some blank. If there are more than 4, you can draw the others below the stars.
